Job Descriptions

PETTY OFFICER MOTORMAN (POM)

General

- Department: Engine
- Reporting to: 2nd Engineer/EOW

Basic functions

Undertake maintenance and cleaning work in the engine room under instruction from the 2nd Engineer/EOOW

Duties and responsibilities

- Assist 2nd Engineer / EOW in operations and maintenance works.
- To weld, solder, braze and burn as required (following suitable training).
- To carry out planned maintenance on machinery and equipment as directed.
- To assist the Electrician as directed.
- Assist EOW when Bunkering.
- Assist and supervise the handling and stowage of engine stores and spare gear.
- Assist in repairs on Deck as directed.
- Assist in maintenance and repair of all mechanical equipment, pipelines, valves, and structural steel work.
- Responsible for the incinerator and maintaining oil levels

- To observe all applicable regulations in respect of safe working practices and pollution prevention.
- Engine Watch keeper at Sea and in Port as or when required.
- To carry out all works as ordered to ensure that vessel is in all respects ready to sail.
- To perform other duties as required by the Chief Engineer or 2nd Engineer.

Other

COOK

General

- Department: Catering
- Reporting to: CPO Caterer

Basic functions

To ensure the preparation of healthy meals, to maintain a high standard of hygiene in the catering department and that sufficient provisions are available for the intended voyage.

Duties and responsibilities

- To prepare the menu and meals for all personnel on board, taking into account ethnic requirements of personnel.
- Cleaning of all areas under their responsibility.
- Maintenance of galley equipment in co-operation with other Officers.
- Control of fridges and storerooms.
- Keeping stock control of all provisions.
- Ordering of provisions.
- To observe all applicable regulations in respect of safe working practices and pollution prevention.
- To perform other duties as required by the Master.
- Compiling varied and properly balanced daily menus in conjunction with the Cook Steward.
- Cooking and supervising the serving of meals for Officers, Ratings, and official functions.
- Maintaining stock control and correct stowage of provisions when loading and during the voyage to ensure that they are used before their 'sell by' or 'best before' date and to minimise wastage.
- Keeping the galley, service areas and storerooms are always clean and tidy.
- Observing good food hygiene practices together with sound health and safety practices and ensuring that others do the same in areas under their control.
- Ensuring that stoves are switched off when the galley is unattended for any length of time and arranging for the Electrician/Engineers to isolate the same overnight.
- Carrying out the baking requirements.
- Inspecting vegetable room stock regularly and ensuring that ripe fruits and vegetables are used first to preserve stocks for as long as possible.
- Disposing of galley waste and storeroom rubbish in the prescribed manner.
- Security duties as described in the 'Ship Security Plan'.
- To perform other duties as required by the Master.
